Details of the Tournament

1. The tournament will be limited to the first 28 pairs (book early to avoid disappointment)
2. Each pair will play 3 games EITHER 9.30am, 12.20pm and 3.10 pm or 10.55am, 1.45pm or 4.35pm
3. Games will consist of 10 ends or one hour and fifteen minutes whichever is the shorter. When the bell sounds to mark the end of the session, no new end to be commenced, should an end be in progress or the jack centred before the bell sounds that end may be concluded. No trial ends, with only ONE shot to count on the first end of each new game. Killing of an end will result in the end being counted and a forfeit of 2 shots to the opposition. This applies to the first end as well.
4. The winner will be decided by 3 points for a win, one point for a draw and one point for each end won by each team. In the event of a tie, overall shot difference will decide the winner.
5. The umpire's decision is final in all queries
6. Score cards to be signed by both skips and handed in to the organisers as soon as possible
7. Entry fee - £24.00 per pair (£12 each person), which will include lunch (cheques payable to Cranbrook Bowls Club)
8. Dress – Whites or whites with club coloured shirts
9. There will be a raffle, plus light refreshments are available throughout the day
